1. Chénas Château du Bois de la Salle Cru Beaujolais 2016 8.50 32.50
Warm, rich Beaujolais with a beautiful deep colour and lots of black fruit flavour. (ABV: 13%)
2. Côte-de-Brouilly Daniel Bouland 2017 37.95
Rich spicy fruit. Beats most Bourgogne Pinot Noir hands down! (ABV: 13.5%)

Bordeaux

1. Château Haut-Pougnan Bordeaux Supérieur 2017 7.95 29.95
Rich sappy Merlot fruit with nice structure. (ABV: 12.5%)
2. Château Lestrilie Capmartin Bordeaux Supérieur 2012 34.00
Lovely mature Claret. (ABV: 13%)
3. Château Lamothe-Cissac Cru Bourgeois Haut Medoc 2015 9.95 39.95
Open Cabernet fruit, plenty of flavour and a good finish. (ABV: 12.5%)

Burgundy

1. Mercurey 1er Cru Clos des Myglands Domaine Faiveley 2017 48.00
Good structure, bright fruit, with flavours of redcurrants and cherries, and a touch of oak. Good value. [Founded 1825, Domaine Faiveley continues to be run by the Faiveley family.] (ABV: 13%)
2. Gevrey-Chambertin Thierry Mortet 2014 59.95
A tight core of red fruit and well-integrated tannins. (ABV: 13%)
3. Chambolle-Musigny Domaine Amiot-Servelle 2015 65.00
Organic. Fragrant and delicate. (ABV: 13%)

1. Côtes-du-Rhône Domaine Andre Brunel Est Ouest 2017 7.95 29.95
Soft, well-balanced & good drinking! (ABV: 13.5%)
2. Crozes Hermitages Vieilles Vignes Domaine du Murinais 2017 39.95
Full, spicy, berry fruit. No oak. (ABV: 13%)

Southern France

1. Pinot Noir Domaine de Valmoissine Louis Latour 7.75 29.95
Provence 2016
Soft, ripe and almost Burgundian. (ABV: 13.5%)
