

## Wines by the Glass

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### Champagne & Sparkling

#### Champagne

1. **Forget-Brimont Brut 1er Cru** 9.95  
A growers Champagne mostly made from Pinot. Attractive soft fruit and nicely balanced. There is good proportion of Grand Cru Champagne in this cuvée. (ABV: 12%)

#### Italy

1. **Prosecco di Conegliano Valdobbiadene DOCG Carpena Malvolti Brut** 7.95  
Our prosecco is very good quality, and properly dry. (ABV: 11%)

### White Wines

#### Alsace

1. **Pinot Blanc Les Princes Abbés Domaines Schlumberger 2017** 8.50  
Fresh, crisp and lively, a perfect aperitif. (ABV: 12.5%)

#### Burgundy

1. **Macon Villages Domaine de L'Elite 2017** 8.45  
Good entry-level white Burgundy. Delicious fruit. (ABV: 13%)
2. **Saint Veran Domaine Botti 2018** 8.95  
Good, all-round, white Burgundy. Definitely punches above its weight. (ABV: 13%)
3. **Petit Chablis Domaine Garnier 2015** 9.95  
Light, restrained, elegant, minerally. (ABV: 12.5%)

#### Loire

1. **Sauvignon de Touraine Les Grenettes Domaine Beausejour 2018** 7.95  
Light, crisp, dry and refreshing. (ABV: 12.5%)
2. **Sancerre Lucien Crochet 2018** 9.95  
Taut and minerally! (ABV: 13%)
3. **Pouilly-Fumé Domaine Jeannot 2018** 9.95  
Delicate & pure Sauvignon Blanc from this small domaine. (ABV: 13%)

#### Southern France

1. **Picpoul de Pinet Tournee du Sud 2019** 7.75  
Fresh, light, aromatic, and lively Languedoc white. Delicious aperitif. Only 12% alcohol! (ABV: 12%)

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2. Louis Latour Chardonnay Coteaux de l'Ardèche 2017 7.95  
Soft, rounded, no oak. (ABV: 13.5%)

### Italy

1. Pinot Grigio Andrea di Pec Venezia Giulia 2018 7.75  
At last a Pinot Grigio that tastes of Pinot Grigio! Dry but soft lingering fruit.  
(ABV: 12%)

### New Zealand

1. Saint Clair Origin Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough 2018 8.50  
Light, elegant and zingy. What NZ Sauvignon is all about. (ABV: 13%)
2. Saint Clair Riesling Marlborough 2018 8.50  
Very clean, light, elegant & dry - nice touch of lime. Great aperitif. (ABV: 12%)

### Spain

1. Antina Sauvignon Blanc Tierra de Castilla 2018 5.95  
Light and fresh. (ABV: 12.5%)

## Red Wines

### Beaujolais

1. Chénas Château du Bois de la Salle Cru Beaujolais 2016 8.50  
Warm, rich Beaujolais with a beautiful deep colour and lots of black fruit flavour. (ABV: 13%)

### Bordeaux

1. Château Haut-Pougnan Bordeaux Supérieur 2017 7.95  
Rich sappy Merlot fruit with nice structure. (ABV: 12.5%)
2. Château Lamothe-Cissac Cru Bourgeois Haut Medoc 2015 9.95  
Open Cabernet fruit, plenty of flavour and a good finish. (ABV: 12.5%)

### Rhone

1. Côtes-du-Rhône Domaine Andre Brunel Est Ouest 2017 7.95  
Soft, well-balanced & good drinking! (ABV: 13.5%)

### Southern France

1. Pinot Noir Domaine de Valmoissine Louis Latour Provence 2016 7.75  
Soft, ripe and almost Burgundian. (ABV: 13.5%)

### Argentina

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1. **Malbec Doña Paula Mendoza 2018** 7.75  
Hand-picked grapes. Big, soft, chocolate/prune red from the adopted home of Malbec. Very good value. (ABV: 14%)

### **Spain**

1. **Antina Tempranillo Cabernet Sauvignon Tierra de Castilla 2018** 5.95  
Uncomplicated easy drinking. (ABV: 12.5%)
2. **Bodegas Muriel Reserva Fincas de la Villa Rioja Alavesa 2014** 8.95  
Delicious cherry fruit, and not over-oaked. (ABV: 13.5%)
